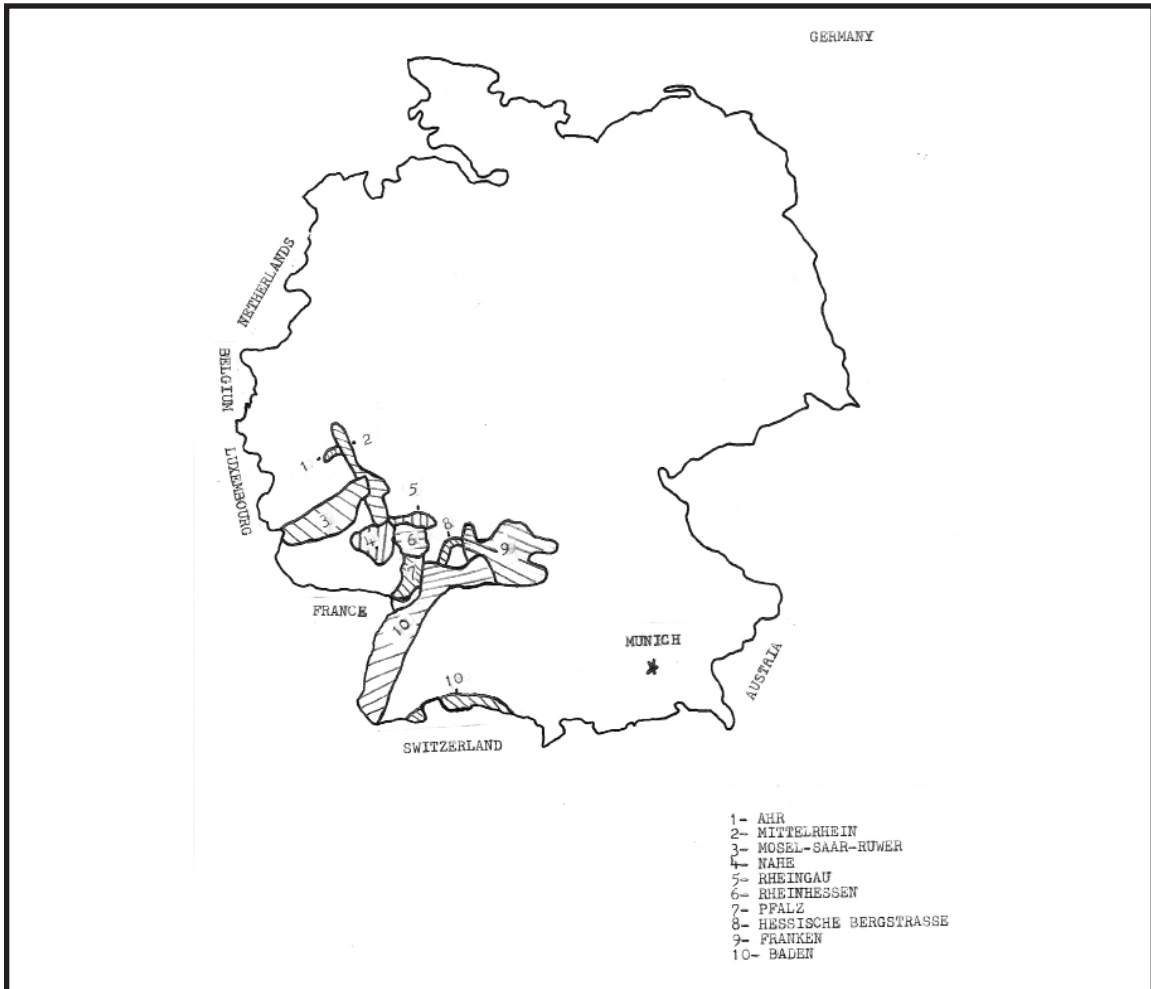

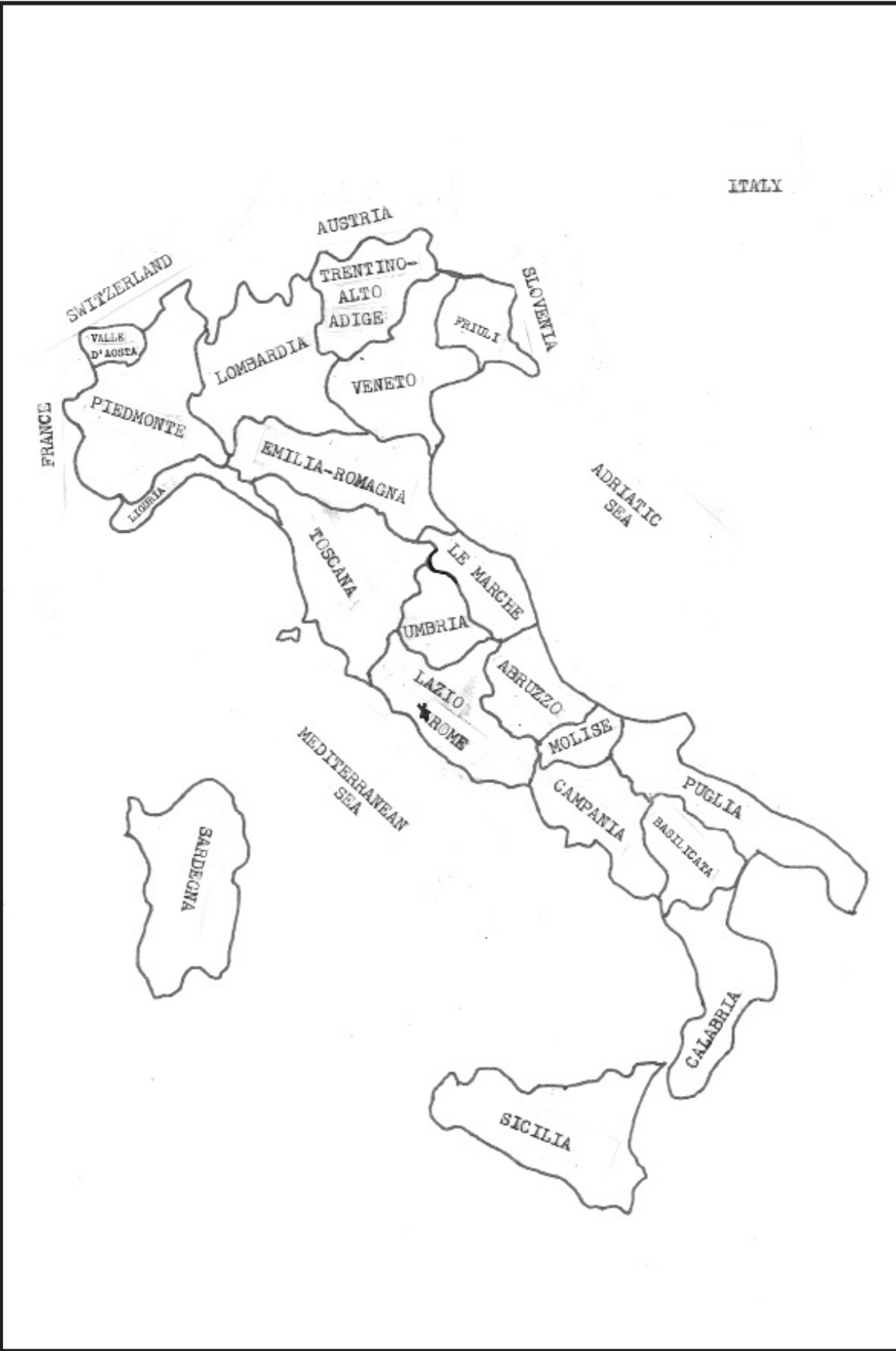

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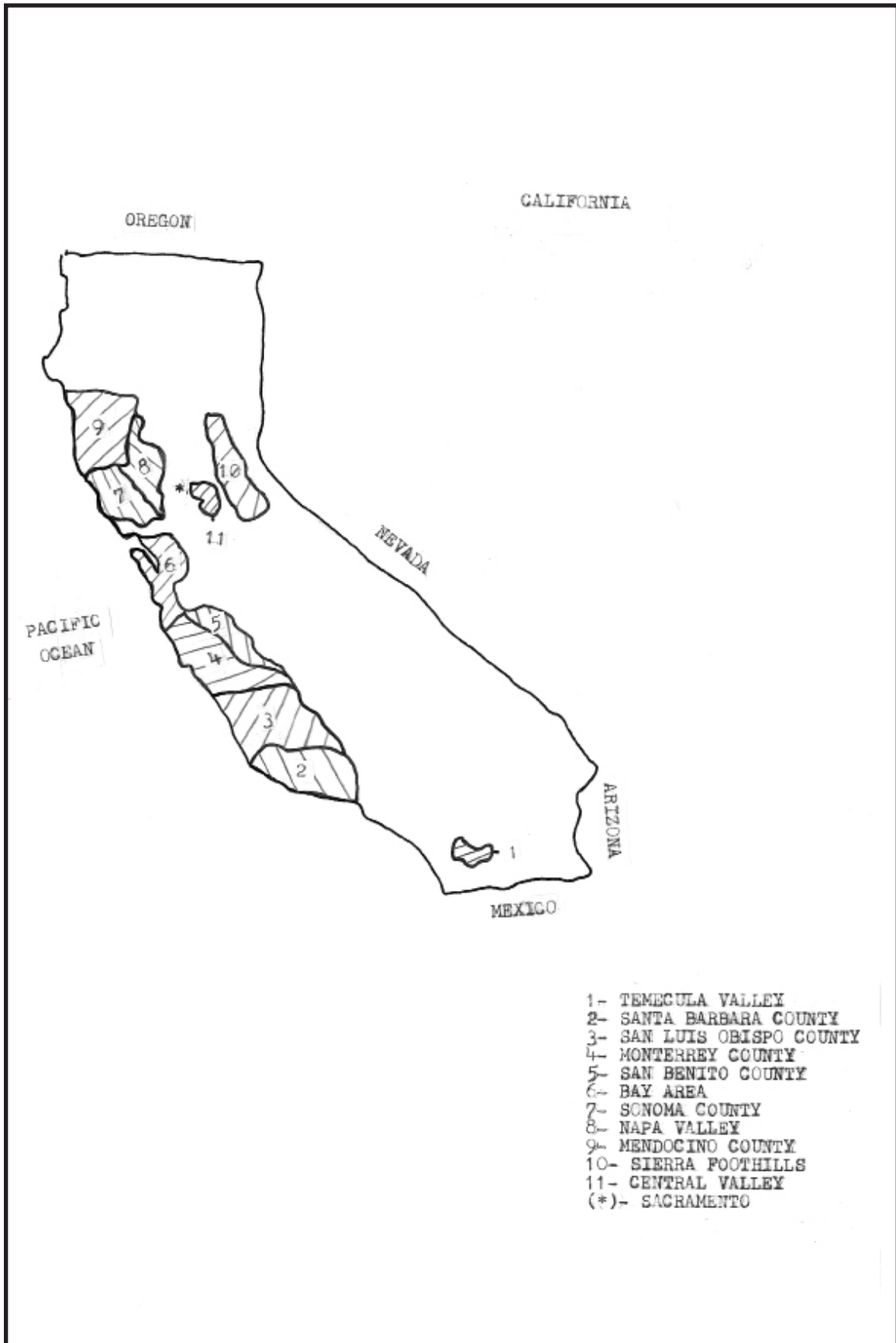

BEAUJOLAIS IS SUMMER'S 'COOL' RED WINE

As summer approaches and temperatures rise, we all look for ways to beat the heat. For red wine drinkers a great way to do this is to check out lighter, less tannic wines served with a little chill. The Beaujolais region and its signature grape, Gamay fit the bill perfectly. The wines produced here are softer and fruitier than their fancy Northern neighbor, Burgundy proper. They also offer a much greater value for your money.

Place determines quality. The lightest, easiest drinking wines are grown on the flat Southern plains and labeled simply as Beaujolais. Wines with more weight and concentration are grown in villages in the hilly North and listed as Beaujolais-Villages. The highest quality tier of wines feature the name of the specific village or vineyard where the grapes were grown on the label. At all quality levels the wines are delicious and very food friendly, especially with the lighter dishes and grilled fare we tend to eat during the summer months. Below is a selection of some of our favorite producers from each quality category. Enjoy!

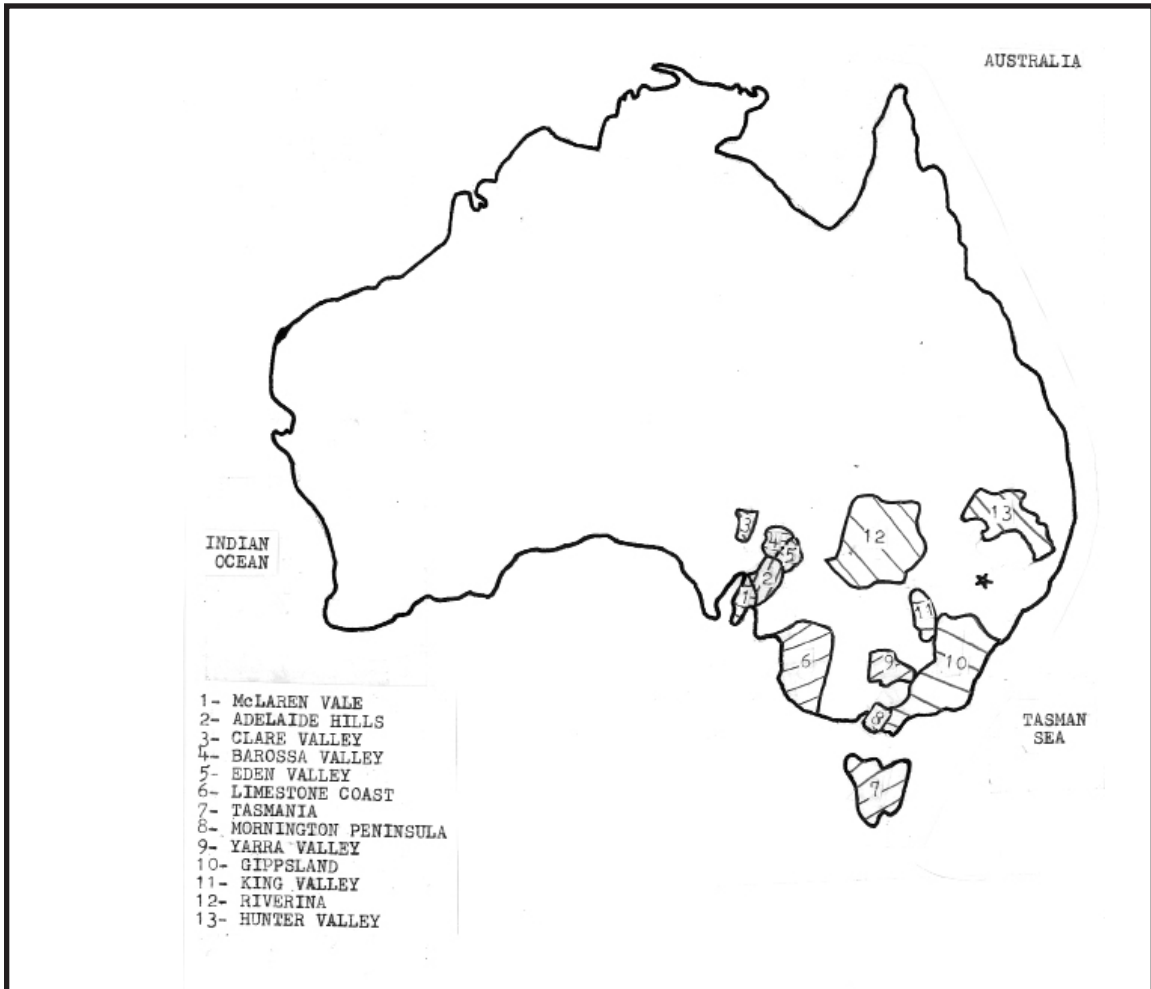

THE RARE WINE COMPANY’S HISTORIC SERIES

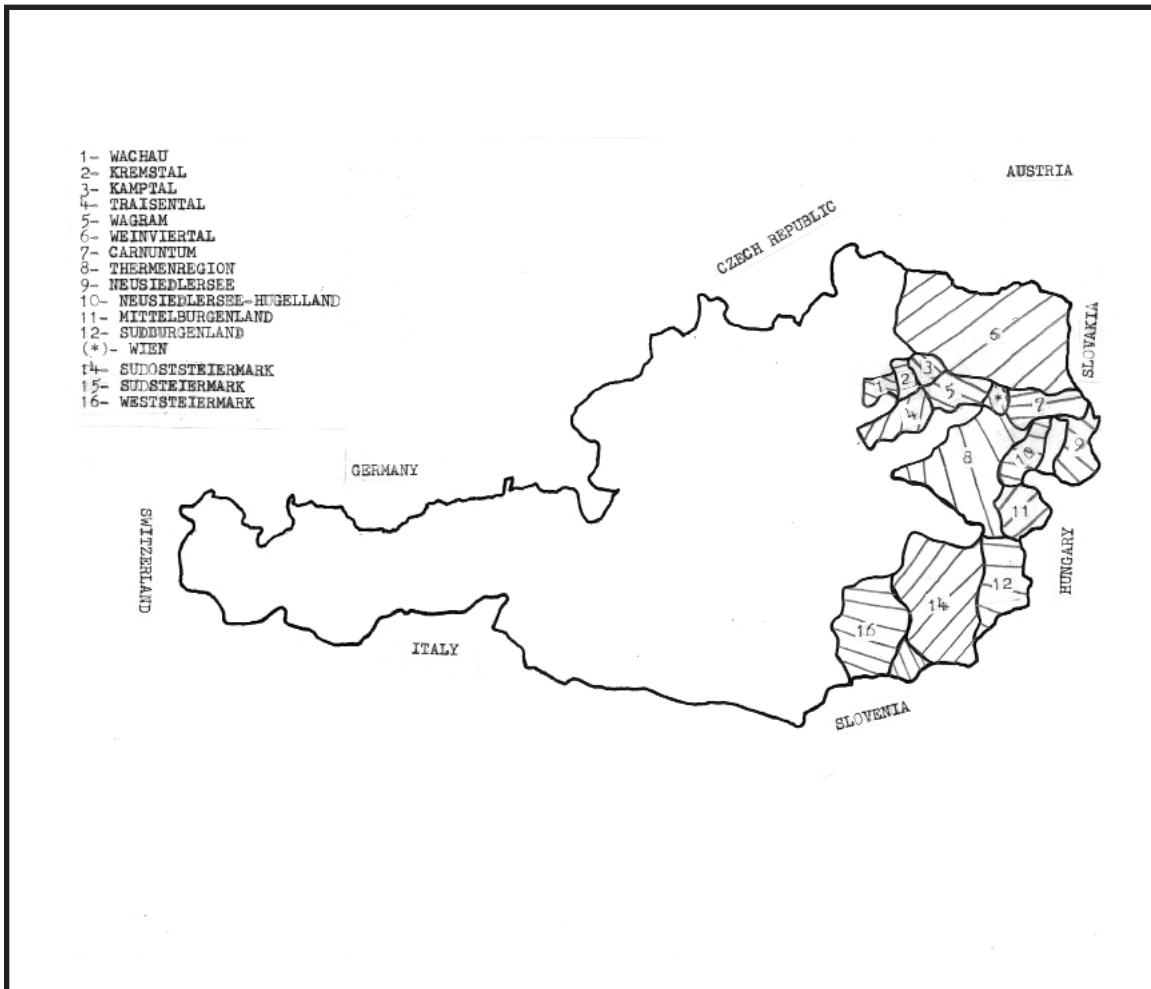

THE MASTER OF NOBLE ROT

Often times people think of dessert wines as being too sweet and un balanced. Weinlaubenhof Kracher has made their name by defying those ideas. Three generations of winemakers have taken the winery to the very top of their industry by consistently producing wines of incredible balance, finesse and character.
